



Protect Voting Rights Petition

The League of Women Voters of Wyoming is a nonpartisan statewide organization that defends democracy and empowers voters.

The League opposes any law-making that fosters distrust in our elections, creates unwarranted barriers to registration, limits access to the ballot box, or undermines our constitutional right to vote.

Wyoming's county clerks run free, fair, secure, and accessible elections. Yet, our elections are coming under increasing attack from our elected officials.

Last year alone, 45 bills were introduced to make it harder for eligible everyday Wyoming citizens to vote. Working parents, shift workers, senior citizens, people with disabilities, and our rural neighbors face increasing obstacles to voting. While many bills did not pass, several will be back in the 2026 legislative session.

We urge the Wyoming Legislature to oppose legislation that creates unwarranted barriers to hard-working, honest Wyomingites casting their votes.

For over 60 years, the Wyoming League has defended the constitutional right to vote. Sign this petition and join in our mission by signing this petition.
